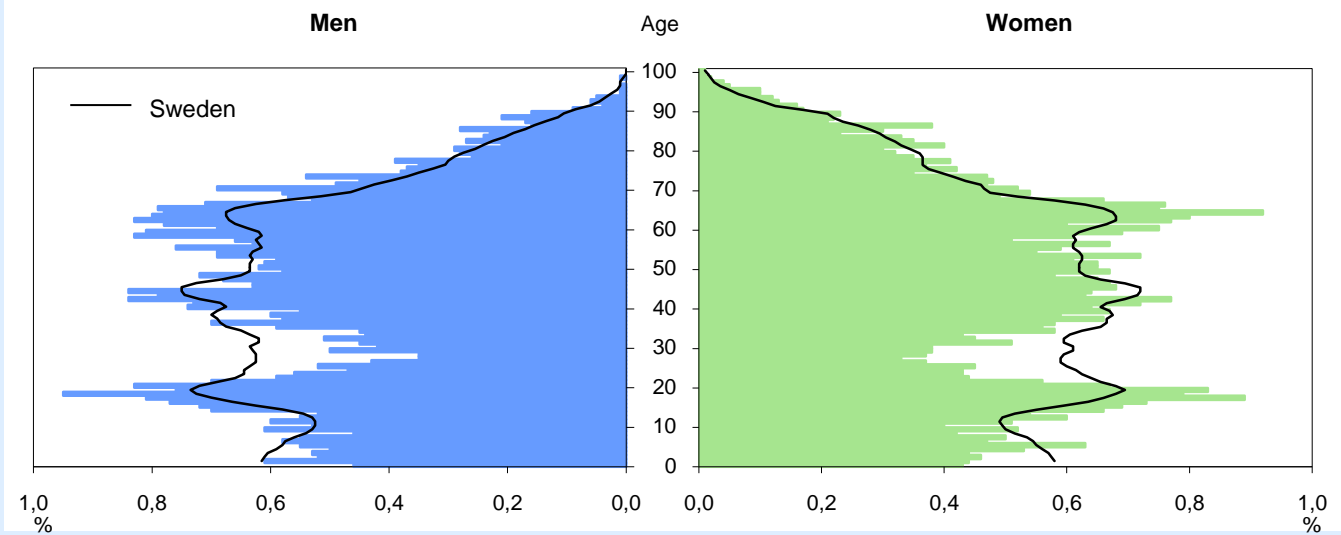

Population by age, 2009



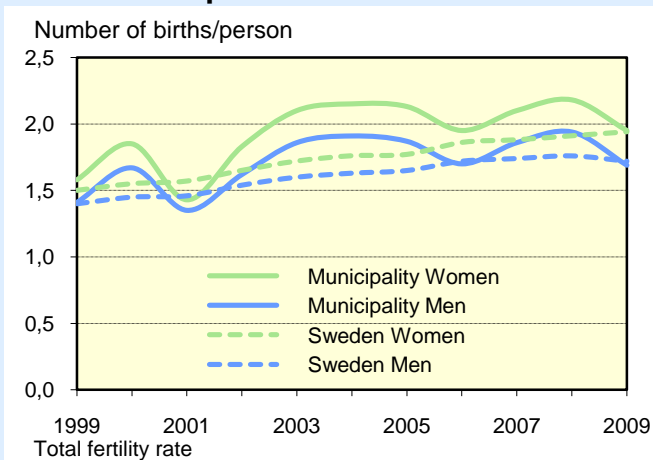

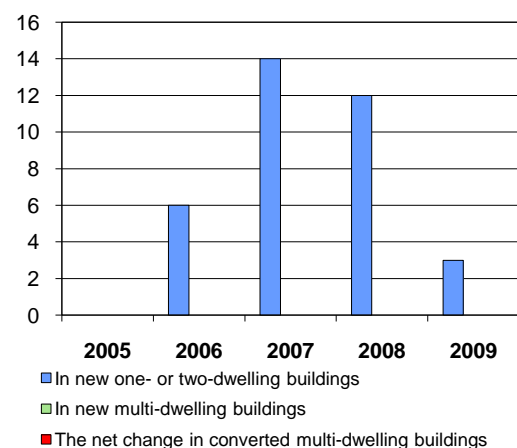

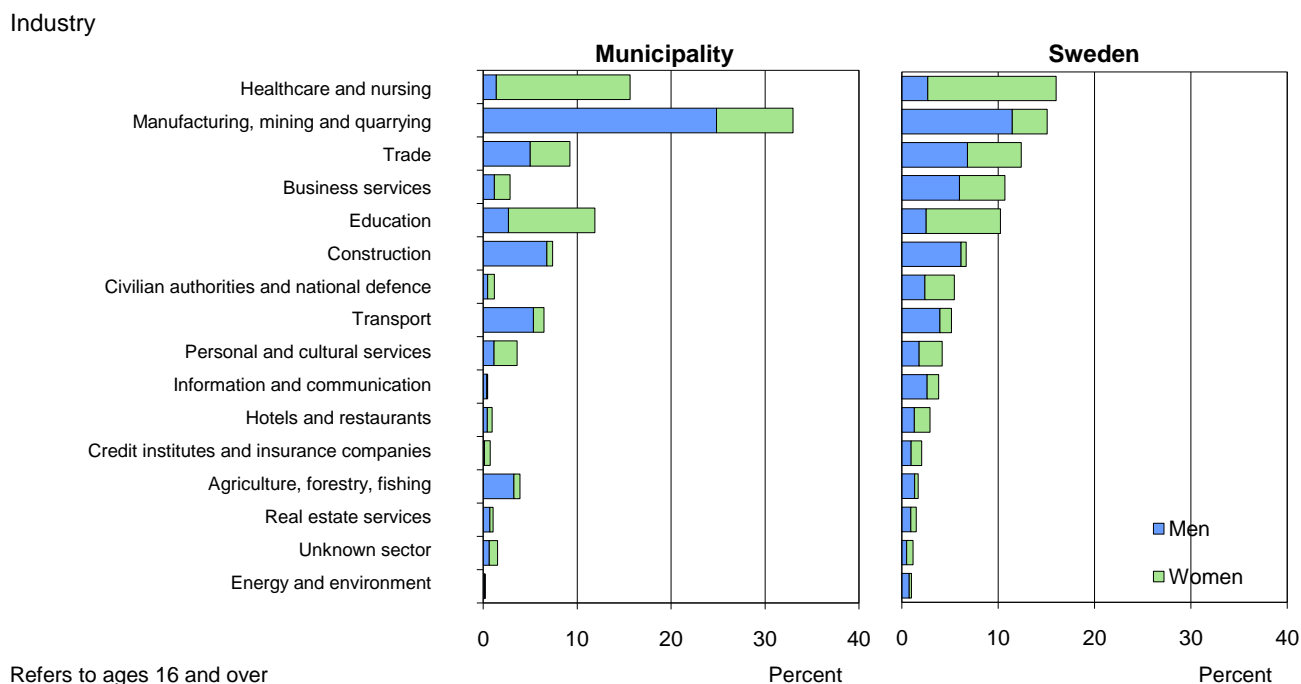

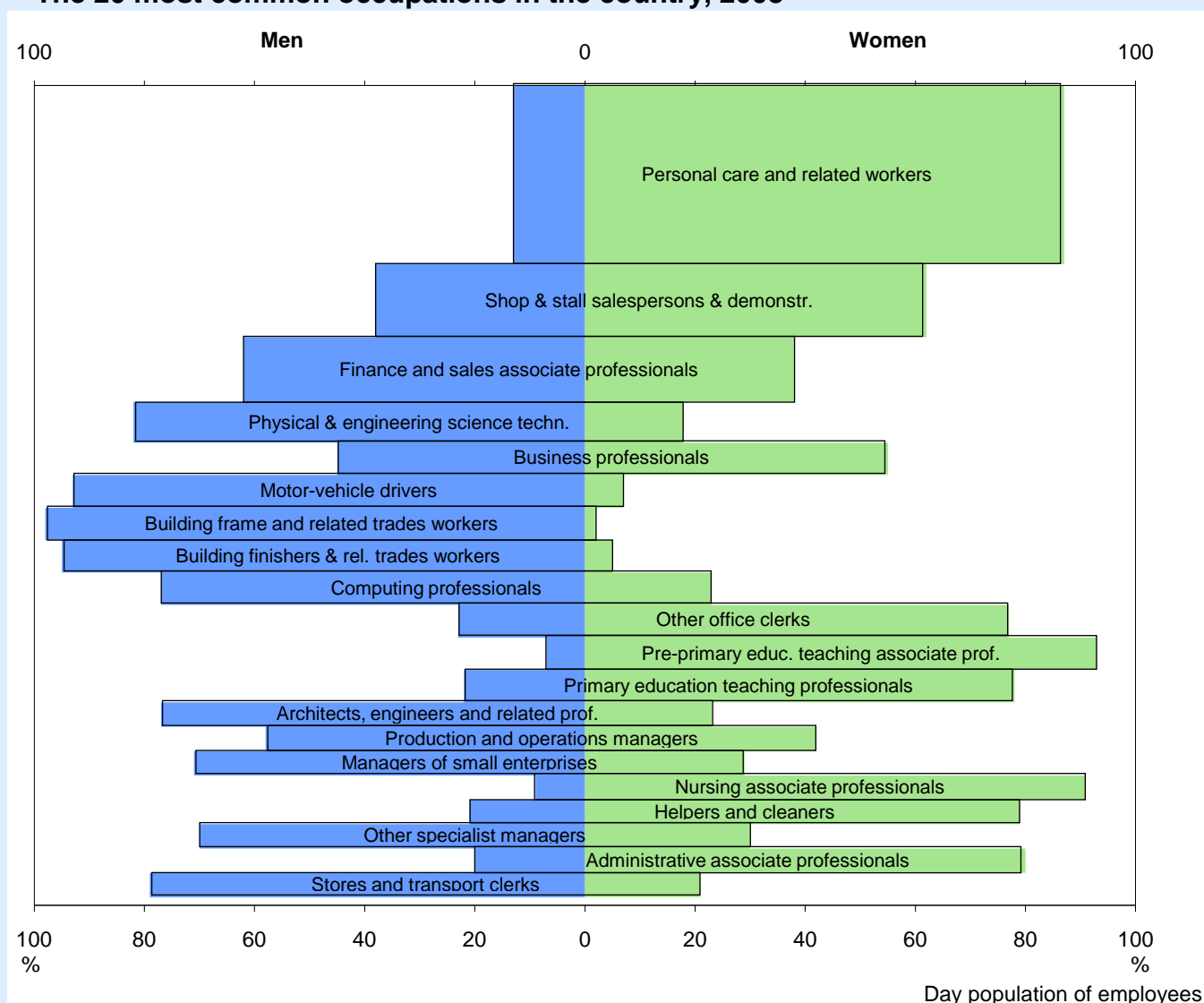

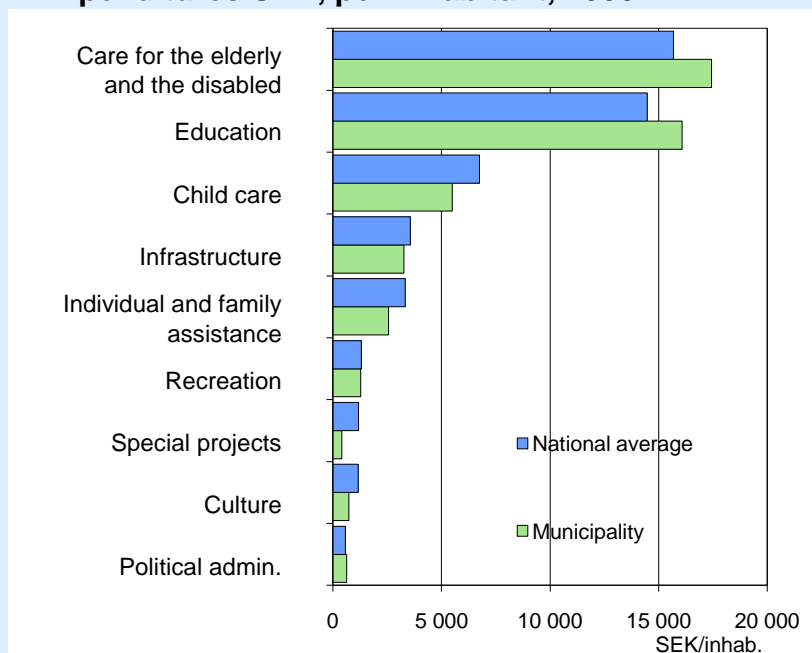
